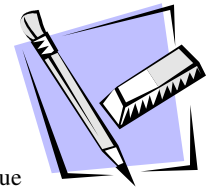


2009-2010 School Supplies List

To help you with your school shopping, we are including a list of supplies your child will need at his or her grade level for the 2009-2010 school year. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to call the school.



KINDERGARTEN Book bag (large enough to fit folders), box of 24 Crayola crayons, 6 large glue sticks (no glue pens or bottles please), traditional size pencil box (no bags please), blunt-end Fiskar scissors, 2 large pink erasers, bound composition notebook, sneakers for physical education (we have gym daily), dry erase markers, 2-2 pocket folders, 1 green, 1 choice. An old, adult, button up shirt for paint smock. A few things to keep in mind for the start of kindergarten:

- Glue sticks and crayons will need to be replenished several times through out the year as we use them so often.
- Crayola crayons last longer and have truer colors than the cheaper brands.
- Please label all of your child's supplies before they come on the first day of school. This will ensure your child's supplies do not get mixed up with any other students.

K/1 MULTIAGE Book bag, 3-2 Pocket folders (1-yellow, 1-green, 1-free choice), 24 count Crayola crayons (no larger), Fiskar scissors, bound composition notebook, 6 large glue sticks (no glue pens or bottles please), traditional size plastic pencil/crayon box, pencils, 2 large pink erasers, dry erase markers, sneakers for gym (we have gym everyday), small blanket and pillow.

FIRST GRADE Book bag, pocket folder, 24 count Crayola crayons (no larger), Fiskar scissors, 4 oz. Elmer's glue, one large pink eraser, sneakers for gym, 1 package #2 pencils, pencil/crayon box.

SECOND GRADE Book bag, a 1" three-ring clear view binder, 5 pocket folders - 4 solid colors (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue) and 1 free choice, 24 count Crayola crayons (no larger), colored pencils, Fiskar scissors, bound composition notebook, and glue sticks, pencil/crayon box, pencils and erasers to be replenished as needed. **Optional:** 8 count Crayola markers.

THIRD GRADE Wide rule loose leaf paper, pencils (1pack #2) and erasers, 24 count Crayola crayons (no larger), glue sticks, Fiskar scissors, clean sock (for classroom slates), wooden ruler (metric and customary), bound composition notebook, 3 subject spiral notebook, 5 pocket folders, 8 count Crayola markers (optional), and highlighters, 4 dry erase markers, and colored pencils. 1 folder for Music class.

FOURTH GRADE Loose leaf paper, lots of pencils, colored pencils (small selection), plastic front and back 5 subject spiral notebook (avoid pages that are perforated), glue stick, 1 highlighter, at least 5 sturdy pocket folders, NO TRAPPER KEEPERS PLEASE, Mrs. Zajchenko's class will need 1 composition notebook and Mrs. Switzer's class will need 2 composition notebooks. 1 folder for Music class.

FIFTH GRADE

Reading: composition notebook, pocket folder

Spanish: 1 binder/folder, pens or pencils, loose leaf paper

Home Living: 2 pocket folders, paper, pens and pencils

All subjects-7 section accordion folder, 4-5 pkgs. of lined paper, #2 pencils, large erasers, a handheld pencil sharpener (that holds the shavings), 3 composition notebooks, highlighter, 3 plastic pocket folders, 1 pkg. of 100 index cards, 1 pkg. of 12 colored pencils, 1 zippered pencil holder (for Math).

SIXTH GRADE

Spanish: 1 binder/folder, pens or pencils, loose leaf paper

Home Living: 2 pocket folders, paper, pens and pencils

All subjects-7 section accordion folder, 4-5 pkgs. of lined paper, #2 pencils, large erasers, a handheld pencil sharpener (that holds the shavings), 3 ring binder(1-1½ w/dividers), 2 marbled composition notebooks, highlighter, 3 plastic pocket folders, 2 pkgs. of 100 index cards, 1 pkg. of 12 colored pencils, 1 zippered pencil holder (for Math), compass (optional).

SEVENTH AND EIGHTH GRADE

ELA: 1 pocket folder, 3-ring binder with dividers, loose paper, 3-hole punch insert for

History: 3-ring binder with 10 dividers, blue and black pens, spiral notebook

Math: spiral notebook, pencils, calculator (optional)

Science: 3- subject 3-ring binder, 3 -hole punch which clips into the binder (can be found at the dollar store), pencil case which clips into the binder with 2 pencils, 2 pens, a pack of colored pencils, and a glue stick

Spanish: 1 binder/folder, pens or pencils, loose leaf paper

Home Living: 3-ring binder (soft cover, one that bends), loose leaf paper and dividers for 5 units, pens and pencils, plastic cup/glass with name on it

Technology: 1- 2"-3" three ring binder, pencils, erasers, loose leaf paper, ruler-(optional)
