Required Notifications

EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY (POLICY 6120)

The Avoca School District is an equal opportunity employer and does not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment in its programs and activities on the basis of legally protected class or category including, but not limited to: age; race; creed; religion; color; national origin; sexual orientation; gender identity or expression; military status; sex; disability; predisposing genetic characteristics; familial status; marital status; status as a victim of domestic violence; and criminal arrest or conviction record.

PUBLIC ACCESS TO STUDENT RECORDS (POLICY 7240)

The School District shall comply with the provisions of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA). Under its provisions, parents/guardians and noncustodial parent(s), whose rights are not limited by court order or formal agreement, of a student under eighteen (18), or a student who is eighteen (18) years of age or older or who is attending an institution of post-secondary education, have a right to inspect and review any and all education records maintained by the School District.

CHALLENGE TO STUDENT RECORDS

Parents/guardians of a student under the age of eighteen (18), or a student who is eighteen (18) years of age or older or who is attending an institution of post-secondary education, shall have an opportunity for a hearing to challenge the content of the school records, to ensure that the records are not inaccurate, misleading, or otherwise in violation of the privacy of students, and to provide an opportunity for the correction or deletion of any such inaccurate, misleading, or otherwise inappropriate data contained therein.

STUDENT DIRECTORY INFORMATION (POLICY 7241)

The District shall publish an annual public notice informing parents or eligible students (i.e., a student eighteen (18) years of age or older or who is attending an institution of postsecondary education) of the District's definition of directory information, the parent/eligible student's right to refuse the release of student directory information and indication of the time period for their response. (Directory information is information contained in an education record of a student that would not generally be considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if disclosed.) Following such public notice



Updated Cell Phone Policy: Beginning in the 2025–26 school year, all NYS public schools are required to adopt a policy prohibiting student use of internet-enabled electronic devices during the school day. Students will not be permitted to use devices capable of texting, accessing social media, or connecting to the internet during the school day, from arrival to dismissal, including lunch, recess, and passing periods. and a reasonable response period, the District may release such information to an outside group without individual consent.

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) defines student directory information as any of the items as indicated in the following list. The Avoca Central School District will release the following defined directory information:

- Name and parent name
- Address
- Telephone listing
- Date and place of birth
- Major field of study
- Grade level
- Participation in sports and activities
- Weight and height (for members of athletic teams)
- Dates of attendance
- Honors, degrees, and awards
- Email address
- Photograph
- Name of educational institution previously attended
- Artwork and voice

MILITARY RECRUITERS' ACCESS (POLICY 7242)

The School District shall comply with a request by a Military Recruiter for names, addresses, and telephone listings of eligible students. Eligible student under ESEA and the National Defense Authorization Act is defined as a secondary student who is seventeen (17) years of age or older or in the eleventh grade (or its equivalent) or higher. Under ESEA and the National Defense Authorization Act, parents must be notified that the School District by law routinely discloses students' names, addresses, and telephone listings to Military Recruiters upon request, subject to a parent's/eligible student's request not to disclose such information with written parental verification of such request.

ATTENDANCE POLICY (POLICY 7110)

The Board of Education recognizes that regular school attendance is a major component of academic success. Through implementation of this policy, the Board expects to improve student attendance, reduce unexcused absences, tardiness, and early departures (referred to in this policy "ATEDs"), encourage full attendance by all students, maintain an adequate attendance recordkeeping system,

identify patterns of student ATEDs and develop effective intervention strategies to improve school attendance.

LIST OF ACCEPTABLE EXCUSES

Listed below are the only excuses the State of New York's Department of Education, recognizes as Excused Absences.

- **1.** Personal illness
- 2. Illness or death in the family
- **3.** Impassable roads due to inclement weather
- 4. Religious observance
- **5.** Ouarantine
- **6.** Required court appearances
- **7.** Attendance at health clinics
- 8. Approved college visits
- **9.** Approved cooperative work programs
- **10.** Military obligations

All others absences are considered unexcused absences.

All ATEDs must be accounted for. It is the parent's responsibility to notify the school office within 24 hours of the ATED and to provide a written excuse within two school days of the student's return to school.

Absence Procedures—if the student has to leave school during the day, email the MHS or Elementary attendance office or send a note with the student that morning. For K-5 students, the note should be given to the teacher. For Middle/High School students, the note should be given to the secretary. The parent of students in grades K-5 must come into the school to sign their student out.
