- 1. To adopt the annual budget of the School District for the fiscal year 2019-2020 and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District.
- 2. That the Board of Education be authorized to expend up to \$168,000 from the existing Transportation Vehicle Replacement Reserve Fund and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District for the purchase of one (1) school bus, two (2) passenger vehicles, and to expend therefore a gross sum not exceeding \$168,000.
- 3. Shall the following resolution be adopted to wit: Resolved that the Board of Education of the Avoca Central School District Is hereby authorized to request additional state aid for energy savings contract improvements under an energy performance contract previously authorized by the board of education; which energy savings contract requires additional voter approval to be eligible for additional enhanced state building aid.
- 4. Shall the District be authorized to acquire an easement at no cost to the District from Russell Robinson and Darlene Robinson for the purpose of running water lines and other utilities to the District's sports fields adjacent to the landowner's property as part of the District's capital project? A full description of the easement is available at the District Clerk's Office during regular business hours, weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- To elect one member of the Board of Education for a five year term commencing July 1, 2019 and expiring on June 30, 2024 to succeed Donald Lester whose term expires on June 30, 2019.

The petition shall describe at least the length of the term of office and contain the name of the last incumbent.
